PCHR condemn brutal terrorist attack in Peshawar calling it an act of cowardice and anti-human

Islamabad: Terrorism in any form and manifestation is condemnable. Not only Islam, but no religion of the world permits killing innocent children on the name of religion. Expressing his deep concern, Chairman Parliamentary Commission for Human Rights (PCHR), Mr. Riaz Fatyana, has strongly condemned the brutal attack on Peshawar Army Public School, which has cost the lives of at least 140 people, the vast majority of whom were children.
